## Terms and Conditions

- Registration fees are \$100 per student per year.
- Checks are payable to “WATS” or “Washington Telugu Samithi”
- Any sibling of a student can register for \$50 each along with the student.
- Minimum Age for first level (beginners) : 6 years as of September 1st , 2011
- Minimum Age for Second Level (advanced) 7 years as of September 1st, 2011
- WATS is not responsible for your child during the time of instruction. You’re welcome to stay around during the time of class, if needed.
- Parents are expected to help their children with homework. This will help your child reach the goals quickly and effectively.
- We provide binders for organizing class work and homework. Students are expected to bring the binders to every class.
- For effective learning, please make sure your child attends at least 90% of the classes in the academic year.
- Learning to speak any language requires a lot of practice. Parents are requested to converse with their children in Telugu as much as possible. This can be just during the time you help your child with Telugu Badi homework or when you find out what the child is learning at Telugu Badi.
- Parents are encouraged to talk to teachers frequently about the progress of their child’s learning.
